### Principal's Notes

**Unity of Purpose...Building Community** - A recurring theme of devotional thoughts at the many beginning of the year meetings has been the importance of how we treat one another and the importance of our witness to others. We want to be reflections of God's love to those whose lives touch ours. A parent has requested that some of the Bible passages used in one of the devotions be referenced in the newsletter for those who were unable to attend the first PALS meeting. Therefore we offer the following thoughts on these four passages and encourage you to read them: 1) *Acts 2:42-47* - a beautiful account of what the Christian community should look like -enjoying fellowship with each other and looking out for the needs of each other - even at personal expense (and note how such love helped the church to daily add to their number!); 2) *Acts 4:32-37* - a repeat of the emphasis on loving and caring for one another, with more incredible examples of self-sacrifice for the well-being of the group; 3) *Ephesians 4:15* - part of a section on "the unity in the Body of Christ" (the church) that emphasizes "speaking the truth in love." While we won't always get along perfectly, or even as well as we'd like, we always address our issues with an attitude and tone of love and concern for our neighbor; 4) *Galatians 5:22-24* is a description of the fruits of the Spirit. These are outstanding examples of the characteristics we should be cultivating as people of God. When (not if!) we are able to put into practice these teachings from the Word, we will experience blessings of relational growth in our community that are beyond imagination. Let us each work diligently toward that goal!

**Faculty In-service Tomorrow!** While the students take tomorrow off, our teachers will be gathering for an in-service on what, in educational jargon, is known as differentiated instruction. While it will have a broader application, the emphasis will be particularly on math. It is a blessing to learn new ways of increasing effectiveness. May each one of us strive to be a life-long learner!
